## ELEMENTARY STUDENT LEADER

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week    1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Weeks    2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Weeks

A student leader in the elementary is a volunteer in training. You will be mentored by an adult SGL. Student leaders are committed to attending at least one service per week and volunteering in an elementary classroom during another service. You will need to have your leader in High School Ministry sign a letter stating that you are attending Ignite, a D-Group or other service. A student leader loves Jesus, and desires to help out SGL as they minister to these elementary kids. Student leaders must be friendly and helpful. You will be responsible for reading the weekly lesson and helping the SGL as needed.

After you fill out a ministry volunteer application, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and mentor you while providing on the job training. You may wish to “shadow” a volunteer in many areas of children’s ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is an elementary student leader, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will be your mentor and ensure that you are properly equipped. You must be in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade or older to serve in elementary department.
